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WELCOME TO FORT LIBERTY

Spanning 251 square miles in the North Carolina countryside is Fort Liberty, one of the largest military installations in the world.

Fort Liberty crosses four counties, borders three towns and offers a family-friendly, community-centric culture that is rich in history, abundant in patriotism and abounding with southern hospitality. It's the largest Army base by population, boasting pleasant year-round temperatures and an easy driving distance to the Appalachian mountains and beautiful Carolina beaches.

Fort Liberty Quick Facts

- Fort Liberty is the largest U.S. Military installation tasked with being a strategic crisis response force ready to deploy anywhere in the world at any time
- It is home of the Airborne and the Special Operations Forces
- The installation supports a population of over 140,000 and is capable of hosting up to 260,000
- The massive base covers approx. 251 square miles (163,000 acres)
- Average temperatures range from the low 30s-50s in winter and 70s-upper 80s in summer
- Nearby Fayetteville is known as the most patriotic city in the U.S.

About Fort Liberty

Fort Liberty is home to approximately 77,000 active duty and reserve soldiers and 63,000 dependents and family members. It makes up nearly 10 percent of all army forces including America's Airborne and Special Operations Forces Command and houses the XVIII Airborne Corps and the 82nd Airborne Division, the U.S. Army Special Operations Command and the U.S. Army Parachute Team, The Golden Knights.

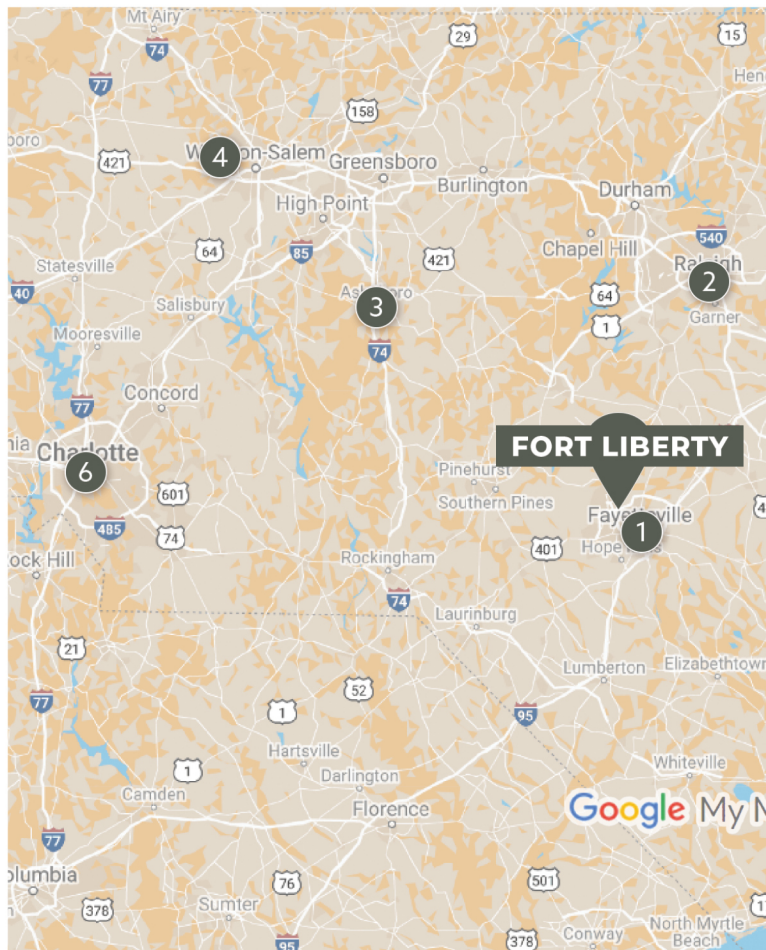

COMMUTING

Surrounding Cities and Major Destinations

No need to leave the state of North Carolina for a wide variety of excursions within a 2-3 hour driving distance of Fort Liberty. The urban attractions of Raleigh and Charlotte, the popular North Carolina Zoo in Asheboro and the scenic beaches of Wilmington are all a worthwhile day trip. Average driving commute times to nearby cities and destinations range between 23 minutes - 2.5 hours and nearby Fayetteville offers a regional airport and Amtrak station for those looking to travel further.

Navigating the country's largest military base can be a bit overwhelming, so it's important to know where on base you'll be posted.

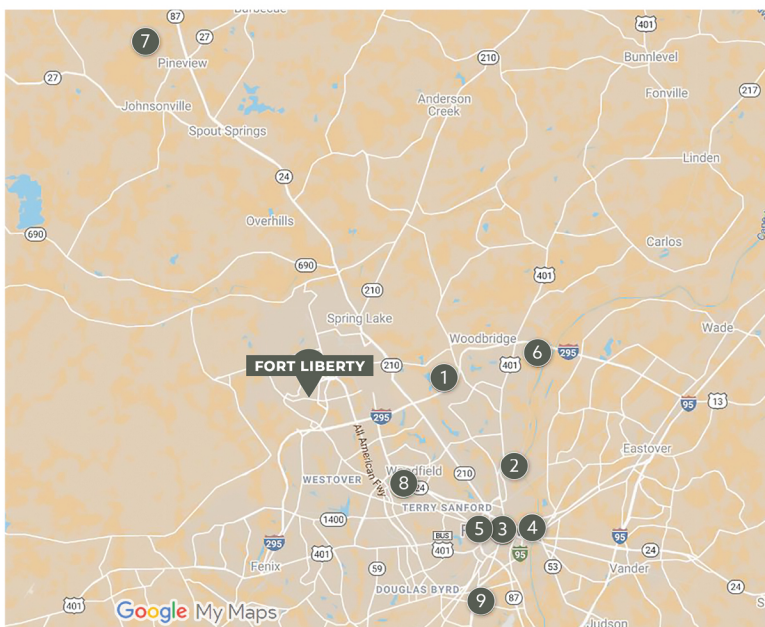
What's Nearby?

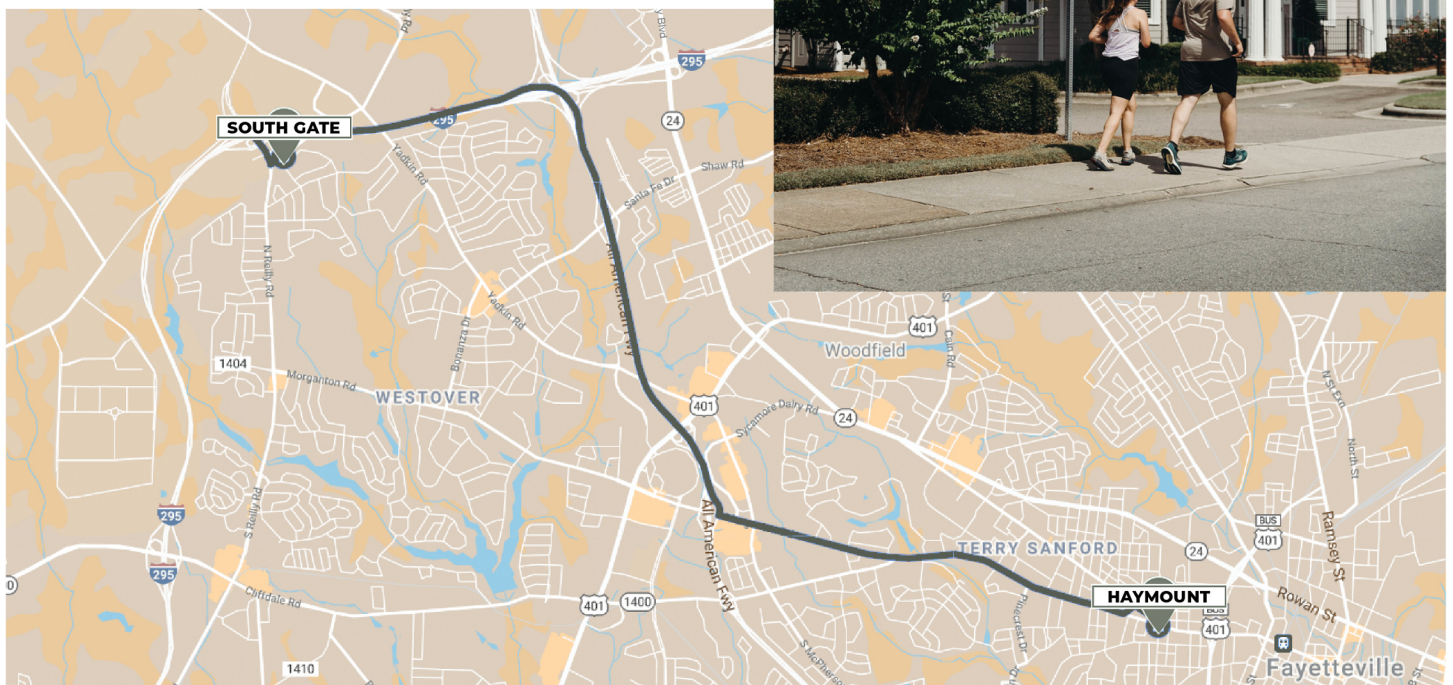

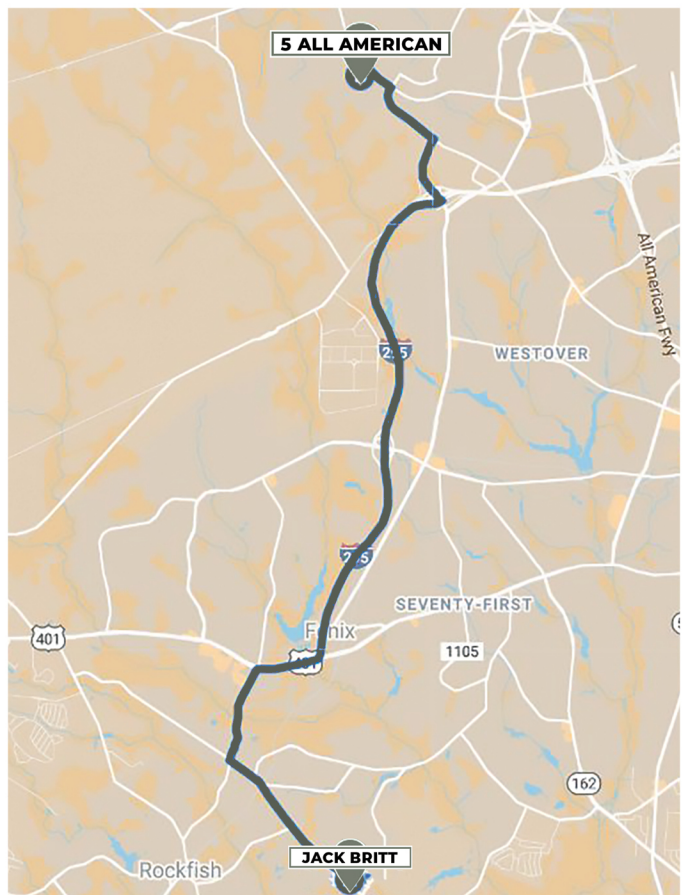

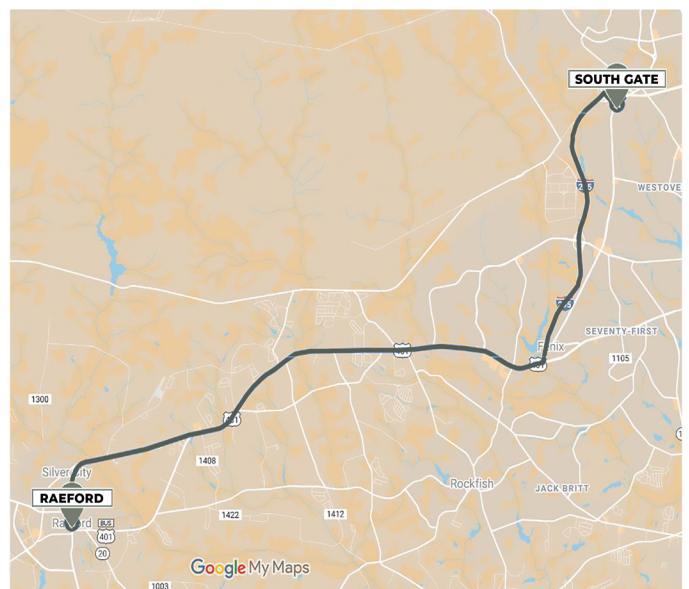
